As part of their annual chapter project, the Troup High School Chapter of the National Honor Society is hosting an assembly titled "Student Safety Presentation" for *girls* 6th grade through Seniors on April 16th at 9:45 am. The speakers from a local non-profit, *For the Silent* will share valuable information to help keep youth safe from potential exploiters and toxic relationships on and offline. The following topics will be covered in the assembly:

Online and offline safety

- Online Predators—ways to stay safe online (privacy settings for social media, how to block and report any unwanted followers/friends on social media)
- Human Trafficking/Exploitation—we will define exploitation/human trafficking, give local and state-wide statistics of trafficking and exploitation, and also give tips on ways to stay safe against predators who may want to lure an adolescent into a potentially exploitative situation

Healthy and Unhealthy Relationships

- Characteristics of a healthy & unhealthy relationships
- Red flags to look out for in an intimate relationship (for example, *if a girl meets a boy and he doesn't want her to have any other close relationships, he keeps tabs on her with a phone and knows all of her passwords or a young girl meets a boy online and he wants to meet in person*)
